Trap schedule	September 22, 2026 (morning)
Cat Quantity	Minimum of 15 cats and a maximum of 50 cats
Package Price per cat	Shouldered by AHVAI – includes trapping, spay/neuter, 2-3 days antibiotics, pain relievers, anti-rabies vaccines, 2-3 days recovery, and use of transfer cages

IMPLEMENTATION PLAN



Biyaya Animal Care will catch 15–50 cats depending on the estimated population per location.

Each cat will be individually caged and labeled based on its capture location (Ex. Basilan St, Ginger and White)

A temporary recovery area will be set up before and after surgery (2–3 days).

All cats will receive:

- Ear notch (for easy identification)
- 2-3 days Injectable antibiotics or Convenia (depending on condition)
- Anti-rabies vaccination

After the recovery period, cats will be returned to their original location.

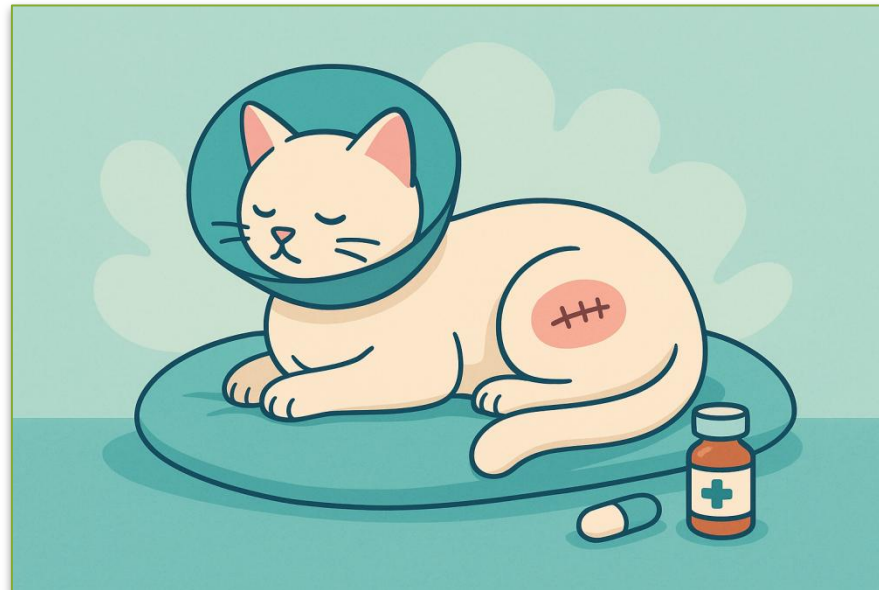
Clients will be notified in advance of the release schedule or delays, if any.



SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS FOR EXTENDED RECOVERY

Cats may not be released within 2–3 days post-surgery in the following cases:

- If the cat has a severe medical condition requiring additional veterinary care.
- If abuse or neglect is suspected, or if the cat is a victim of Animal Welfare Act violations (RA8485 as amended by RA 10631).





BIYAYA ANIMAL CARE REQUESTS

Cats should **NOT** be fed before the catching schedule.

Cats must be healthy. Those with colds or are severely under weight are not allowed.

Owned indoor cats included in the catch must have the owner's prior knowledge and acknowledgment of the possible exposure risk from contact with unvaccinated community stray cats.

Female cats that have recently given birth can only be spayed after 1 to 2 months.

Cats must be at least 6 months old or weigh more than 2kgs.
